Vintage: 2014

Varieties: 53% Syrah 40% Grenache 7% Carignan

Vinification: Hand-picked grapes. Sorting grapes on the table in the cellar. Total destemming of Grenache and Syrah. Gentle extraction by punching down on these particularly careful cuvées of Syrah and Grenache.

Tasting notes: Full and fleshy mouth supported by fine, very ripe tannins, explosion of licorice and violet at the same time. Pleasant sweetness on the palate, silky, fluid palate. remarkable vintage to reserve for aging
